The Fall Carnival Kings and Queens will be the top sellers in each class.

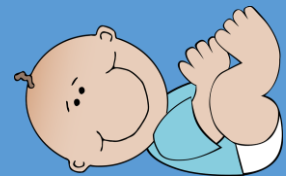
